# 10 x 10 Custom Album

## Single Page

← **Safety Margin (Purple):** Do not place text or artwork closer to the edge than this line.

The only exception is when you want full bleed printing and then your image must extend all the way to the outside edge.

### **Specifications**

Template Size: 10" x 10"  
Margins: 1/2"

**Color Space:** To ensure the most accurate color rendition make sure your file is embedded with an sRGB color space profile.

### **Save as a JPEG for printing:**

**Important** - Before saving as a JPEG, be sure to save the original as a PSD in layers. You will need this layered PSD file for any future edits.

- 1) Each page must be saved as a separate JPEG file, so start by cropping this two page spread exactly in half into two separate files (Crop Tool → 10" x 10" at 300 ppi).
  - 2) Save as JPEG - Quality 10, Baseline ("standard").
- Save each page of the album as a separate JPEG file.
  - Your file names should be the actual page numbers. (i.e. "page\_001.jpg", "page\_002.jpg"...)
  - Custom Albums are available in 20, 30 or 40 pages.
  - The first page will always be on the right. The last page will always be on the left.

We provide two different templates for Custom Album design. One template is a single page and the other shows the full spread (both left and right pages together) This full spread template can be helpful to visualize the congruency of your design over the two adjacent pages, it also helps when introducing panoramic images that cross over the gutter onto both pages.
